Requirements:

- Baccalaureate preparation in Nursing or Food and Nutrition
- Registered Nurse with the College of Nurses of Ontario or, Registered Dietitian with the College of Dietitians of Ontario, in good standing
- Certification as a Diabetes Educator (CDE) preferred
- Minimum of 3 year's experience counselling patients in diabetes clinic incorporating various behaviour change models or techniques for chronic disease management preferred. Experience with insulin therapy; initiation and adjustment a definite asset.
- Demonstrated ability to work autonomously and as a member of an interdisciplinary team.
- Flexibility with work schedule to include one evening per week and able to work in various settings i.e. home visits, outreach sites
